The groups are mixed, Years 7 to 9. Our vision is to ensure that learners re-engage in education and learning through a broad, balanced and highly engaging curriculum. We have kept our curriculum broadly in line with that of other Westminster Secondary Schools so that, as and when our learners are successfully reintegrated back into mainstream, they are in line with their peers.</p> <p>Learners are encouraged to re-engage with learning through smaller group sizes and personalised support, where a love for learning can be re-established and nurtured. Learners are given the opportunity to learn about things that interest them and are supported through a range of interventions, academic support such as 1:1/small group Literacy interventions, behaviour and pastoral support and mentoring.</p> <p>Friday afternoon enrichment is part of our vision to re-engage our learners. Learners have the opportunity to sign up to an activity that interests them, without the constraints and pressures of examinations and grades. Options offered include Sport and PE Club (both onsite and offsite), Reading Club, Film Club, Art Club, Music Club, Games Club, Cooking Club, Poetry/Creative Writing workshops and Pan Arts.</p>
